



## **Concord Kids Regathering Procedures**

The following contains procedures and protocols for reopening the Elementary Kids Ministry at Concord Baptist Church. It is the goal and mission of Concord Kids to provide a safe and positive environment for our families and children. All policies and procedures already set forth by the church will also be followed

### **Team Member Screening**

- All team members will be medically screened each week. Any team member who has a fever over 100.4°F, are exhibit flu-like symptoms, have an outstanding COVID test, or have had direct contact with a person(s) who are COVID positive will be asked to return home.
- Volunteers who temperature screen at door will be required to wear gloves and mask.
- Personal Protection Equipment will be provided for any other volunteer but is not required.

### **Classroom Procedures**

- During Concord's Phase 3, Elementary areas will follow a one-service format, offering either the usual master teacher approach (large group to small group) or one large group event. Some campuses may elect to have elementary age come to sanctuary first for worship, then leave.
- At each campus, kids need to sit 6 feet apart until the start of service, suggest using the "So and So Show" or other media to keep them seated until service starts.
- After service, classes will return to the gym, starting with the class closest to the gym, and so forth.
- CRAFT SUPPLIES WILL NOT BE SHARED. Kids will be provided a bag of supplies to use each week and returned, which will be sanitized weekly.
- All classes will practice social distancing to the best ability. There is no guarantee to parents that kids will be perfectly distanced but we will strive to do the best we can! Floor markers, desks, or tables will be provided to help direct children.

## Sanitization

- Teachers will be provided with hand sanitizer and should provide to kids when entering and leaving room, and just before dismissal.
- After each service, each room needs to be sanitized. Quat bottles, gloves, masks, and rags will be provided. Spray down all chairs, tables, and touched surfaces. Also, at the end, place craft bags in tote opened and spray with quat. Return boxes to Children's Ministry closet.
- Sanitization Records will be kept for each room.
- Welcome team will spray down chairs in large group room and gym while kids are in small group. For other campuses with more than one service, room will need to be sanitized between services.
- Return all supplies to Children's Ministry closet.
- Bathrooms will be sanitized hourly during operation by select volunteers and children's pastor/director.
- All rooms will need to be sanitized and checked after final Sunday service.

## Check-In/Out

- Families will be medically screened before entering any church building. At Clermont, families will be screened before entering Building C to check in kids.
- All welcome desk volunteers will wear personal protection equipment to screen children.
- **Any child with a fever over 100.4°F, exhibit flu-like symptoms, has an outstanding COVID test, or have had direct contact with a person(s) who are COVID positive will be asked to return home.**
- All check-ins will be done by volunteer. No self check-ins.
- At Clermont, kids will take a seat in the gym after sticker applied. For other campuses, volunteers will escort children to designated classes.
- Each campus will have a "flow-chart" of how families will enter and exit buildings to optimize social distancing.
- Depending on the campus, parents will re-enter check-out area practicing social distancing to pick up children.
- **PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN CLASSROOMS. CHILDREN WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE DESK.**
