



## **Regathering for Concord Preschool Kids**

### **Preregistration:**

Parents will register for preschool kids through our church pre-registration site.

### **Screenings:**

1. You should not enter the building if....
  - a. You have a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher.
  - b. You have any respiratory infections, or have had a cough, sneezing regularly, had shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24-48 hours.
  - c. An outstanding COVID test or a direct contact with someone with COVID.
  - d. Temperature screenings will take place for ALL individuals before entering building
  - e. An entire family may enter and be screened at the preschool entrance
  - f. Anyone exhibiting symptoms and/or a fever of 100.4 or higher will be asked to attend services ONLINE at home
  - g. If one person in party, including child, has a fever of 100.4 or higher the entire party will be asked to attend services ONLINE at home
  - h. In accordance with standard procedure prior to COVID-19 pandemic, any children who BECOME sick during preschool will be asked to be taken home by parents immediately

### **Check In:**

1. No touch check in offered by our Preschool Welcome Team
  - a. Child receives security tag; parent receives claim voucher
  - b. Parent must show voucher upon check out, for security purposes
2. Children, toddlers through PreK, will be taken to their rooms by a preschool team member.

- a. No parents will enter preschool hallway to drop off or pick up their child
  - b. Upon entry and exit, children will be able to sanitize their hands.
  - c. Infants may be taken to their rooms by a parent.
3. No diaper bags or any other outside items for toddlers (ie, baby carriers, strollers, backpacks, lovies, blankets, etc)
    - a. For Infants (Birth - 12 months) please send formula and diapers in a **labeled ziploc bag**. Please include instructions for feeding on the ziplock bag.
    - b. For toddlers and other pre-k ages who require diapers, change of clothes, bottles or sippy cups, they will need to bring those items in a **labeled ziplock bag**.

#### **In The Classroom:**

1. Only five rooms will be open per hour. (Not all rooms will be opened during each hour.) This will help us safely open our preschool area and allow for adequate time to clean after services are over.
2. Occupant Capacity is limited based on room size in order to social distance, hence the reservation requirement.
3. Volunteers may wear masks in the classroom but they are not required.
4. Children are not required to wear masks.
  - a. We understand if you send your child with a mask, and will help them keep it on if you wish.
5. Upon entry to the classroom children will have a specific place to sit on the floor socially distanced as best as possible. Engaging non-touch activities will be used throughout their time in the room.
6. Opportunities for teachers to teach during this hour will still be in place with an option to create a large group setting as well.
7. Controlled opportunities for children to have craft activities will be available.
8. Handwashing and hand sanitizing will take place in the classroom throughout the hour.

#### **Check out procedures:**

1. As parents are dismissed from service, they will be asked to social distance as they approach the preschool welcome area to begin pick up procedures.
2. We ask that only one parent/guardian come to pick up their child.

3. All parents must present the security tag to the welcome desk team and their child will be brought to them, maintaining the security protocols previously in place. Matching security tags are required to ensure the children are released to the appropriate families.
4. Each parent and child will be asked to exit out of the preschool entrance after they receive their children.
